Emily Reineke is a Threat Management Consultant with SIGMA. Emily worked at Virginia Tech during the 4 years following the April 2007 tragedy in multiple offices: the Office of Recovery and Support, the Office of the Provost, and the Police Department. She assisted university planning efforts for the first 4 yearly memorials, provided guidance and support for implementing federal grant goals, and was instrumental in managing the newly formed threat assessment team in its first two years.

Emily worked for the Virginia Tech Police Department as the first Threat Assessment Team Coordinator, a position created to retain her expertise in threat assessment and program development. She developed the team mission statement, created a database to manage all threat cases, built the threat assessment team website, designed educational materials for the campus community, and managed information flow for each weekly threat assessment team meeting.

While at Virginia Tech, she collaborated with the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) to plan multiple statewide training opportunities and designed a survey to be administered at the trainings. Additionally, she was invited, along with Dr. Gene Deisinger, to present at the Canadian Association of Threat Assessment Professionals Annual Meeting.

Emily received a Masters degree from Virginia Tech in Educational Leadership & Policy Studies. She is currently working at The Public Health Foundation in Washington DC.
